Tetra is an Australian-made porcelain tile collection inspired by the beauty of handcrafted zellige ceramics. Manufactured on a porcelain body, Tetra is suitable for walls, floors, wet areas, outdoor applications and swimming pools, providing greater design continuity throughout residential and commercial projects.

Available in 20 contemporary colours and a choice of Satin Matt or Gloss finishes, Tetra is designed around a simple three-step selection process.

STEP 1 – CHOOSE YOUR COLOUR

Select from 20 carefully curated colours ranging from soft neutrals and warm earthy tones through to greens, blues and contemporary feature colours.

TETRA ORIGIN

Rustic Character

Tetra Origin captures the beauty of traditional handcrafted ceramics. Featuring rich tonal variation, undulating surfaces and organically imperfect edges, each installation develops a unique sense of movement and character. Origin is ideal for customers seeking an authentic artisan aesthetic with pronounced variation and visual depth.

TETRA NOVA

Subtle Sophistication

Tetra Nova offers a more refined interpretation of the collection. Retaining the charm and texture of handcrafted ceramics while introducing a softer, more consistent appearance, Nova creates a calm and sophisticated finish suited to contemporary interiors.

TETRA FUSION

Dynamic Patchwork

Tetra Fusion is the most expressive range within the collection. Combining plain and patterned faces in a completely random mix, Fusion creates a distinctive patchwork effect that adds texture, depth and individuality to every installation. Fusion is manufactured with approximately two-thirds plain faces and one-third patterned faces. Patterned faces are supplied as a random blend and the ratio and placement of individual patterns cannot be controlled during manufacture, packing or installation.

No two areas will look exactly the same, making Fusion ideal for customers seeking a feature with personality, movement and visual interest.

STEP 3 – CHOOSE YOUR FINISH

Satin Matt

A contemporary low-sheen finish with a P3 slip rating, suitable for walls, floors and swimming pool applications.

Gloss

A reflective finish that enhances colour depth and highlights the handcrafted character of the collection. Suitable for walls and swimming pool applications.

SAMPLE BOXES

Sample boxes are available across all Tetra collections and include four tiles showcasing a variety of faces from the selected product. These sample boxes help customers understand the natural variation, movement and character that can be expected across a full installation.

Tetra is manufactured with 16 unique faces and a V3 Moderate Variation rating.

Tetra Fusion contains a random blend of plain and patterned faces, with approximately two-thirds plain faces and one-third patterned faces.

From time to time, raw material availability may change, requiring the use of alternative suppliers.

We recommend ordering a sample to review the current production of the tile before placing an order.

Consider your order quantity carefully as there are no returns with this product.

INSTALLATION

To cut Tetra tiles, we recommend a wet saw fitted with a continuous rim diamond blade.

We strongly recommend engaging a certified tiler for the installation of our products to ensure the highest quality outcome.

All installers working with SCC products are required to adhere to Australian Standard AS 3958:2023 – Installation of ceramic and stone tiles.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

DO NOT clean Tetra tiles with strong acid or abrasive cleaners.

We recommend using a soft sponge or cloth with a pH-neutral tile cleaner or white vinegar diluted with four parts warm water. Chemicals such as bleach, ammonia, acidic cleaners and alkaline detergents can cause irreversible damage to tile surfaces and should not be used.

We recommend using a pH-neutral cleaner specifically designed for tiles. Southern Cross Ceramics recommends Spirit Neutral Cleaner products.
